Q1: When is the Street Outreach Training and where?

A1: May 13, 2021 1-4 est – this training will be via Webinar. Registration has been sent out via eGrams.

Q2: Who needs to attend the Street Outreach Training?

A2: Anyone that receives Street Outreach funding or has a Street Outreach project, this includes VSPs and PATH agencies.

Q3: Will the Street Outreach training be recorded?

A3: Yes, it will be recorded and posted on the HCA Help Desk. But we encourage you to be there live to ask any questions you might have.

Q4: We do live intake with clients into HMIS, do we still need to complete the intake forms?

A4: No, if you do live intake then you don't need to have the paper forms in the client files.

Q5: What documents are going to be required for the data accuracy plan?

A5: We are still working on the requirements but when your agency is selected, we will notify you then what we are looking for. We are still working through this process.

Q6: Is RKY required to ask the Covid19 Vaccination questions?

A6: No, RKY is not required to ask these questions only HUD funded agencies, but if that is something you would like to ask your clients reach out to Mike Townsend at KHC.

Q7: Do we have to complete the entire form if they answer no to the first questions?

A7: If the client answers No to the vaccination questions then you don't have to ask the remaining questions. Try and get as most information from the client as possible.

Q8: Will these questions show up as errors?

A8: No these questions are not captioned on HUD reports but KHC will be running reports on this data and your agency could be questioned if these questions are not answered.

Q7: What reports are due this summer?

A7: If you receive "regular" ESG funding, not ESG-CV, you will be required to submit your CAPER report for all projects. You will receive an email from KHC if this is a requirement.

Q8: What report needs to be ran for ESG-CV?

A8: For ESG-CV projects you should run the CAPER report and check for errors at the first of each month.
